IT IS ORDERED THAT

 The sewer and water rate tariffs of the Victoria Water and Sewage Commission, as set out in schedules 1 and 2 annexed hereto and forming part of this Order, are approved and declared effective as of October 1, 2017, and shall remain in effect until otherwise ordered by the Commission.

NOTICE

Section 12 of the *Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission Act* reads as follows:

12. The Commission may, in its absolute discretion, review, rescind or vary any order or decision made by it or rehear any application before deciding it.

Parties to this proceeding seeking a review of the Commission's decision or order in this matter may do so by filing with the Commission, at the earliest date, a written **Request for Review**, which clearly states the reasons for the review and the nature of the relief sought.

Sections 13.(1), 13(2), 13(3), and 13(4) of the *Act* provide as follows:

- 13.(1) An appeal lies from a decision or order of the Commission to the Court of Appeal upon a question of law or jurisdiction.
- (2) The appeal shall be made by filing a notice of appeal in the Court of Appeal within twenty days after the decision or order appealed from and the rules of court respecting appeals apply with the necessary changes.
- (3) The Commission shall be deemed to be a party to the appeal.
- (4) No costs shall be payable by any party to an appeal under this section unless the Court of Appeal, in its discretion, for special reasons, so orders.

Sanitary Sewage Rates and Charges

Application:

Rates and charges apply to sanitary sewage services provided to premises served, or capable of being served, by the Victoria Water and Sewage Commission.

Rate:

\$552.00 per unit, per year, in accordance with the *Proportionate Sewage Charges* on page 2 of this tariff.

Service Availability Charge:

An annual rate of \$276.00 shall apply to all properties that are not developed but where sewer service is available for use.
