

## NOTICE OF PROPOSAL – Rural Municipality of Wellington (PID# 755371)

TAKE NOTICE that the Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission (the "Commission") has received a proposal to restructure (the "Proposal") from the Rural Municipality of Wellington (the "Municipality") pursuant to section 15 of the *Municipal Government Act*, RSPEI 1988, c M-12.1 (the "Act").

## BACKGROUND

The Municipality proposes to annex a single parcel of land totaling approximately 0.35 acres located at 165 Mill Road, Wellington (PID# 755371). The owner of the parcel has requested annexation for the purpose of accessing the Municipality's storm sewer expansion project and other municipal services.
