## - PETROLEUM PRICING -

**Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island, January 22, 2021** - The Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission approved the following petroleum prices effective 12:01 a.m., Friday, January 22, 2021:

- There is no change to the price of gasoline; and
- The price of both furnace oil and diesel will increase by 1.0 cents per litre (cpl).

At self-serve outlets, prices for regular unleaded gasoline will range from 111.4 to 112.6 cpl and prices for diesel will range from 117.5 to 118.7 cpl.

The maximum price for furnace oil is 86.7 cpl.

The Commission's next scheduled pricing adjustment is January 29, 2021.
