The following is distributed by Island Information Services at the request of the Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission:

- PETROLEUM PRICING -

Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island, March 19, 2021 - The Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission approved the following petroleum prices effective 12:01 a.m., Friday, March 19, 2021:

- The price of gasoline will increase by 2.5 cents per litre (cpl); and
- There is no change to the price of furnace oil or diesel.

At self-serve outlets, prices for regular unleaded gasoline will range from 131.6 to 132.7 cpl and prices for diesel will range from 127.9 to 129.0 cpl.

The maximum price for furnace oil is 96.2 cpl.

The Commission's next scheduled pricing adjustment is March 26, 2021.
