The following is distributed by Island Information Services at the request of the Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission:

- PETROLEUM PRICING -

Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island, May 7, 2021 - The Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission approved the following petroleum prices effective 12:01 a.m., Friday, May 7, 2021:

- The price of gasoline will increase by 3.0 cents per litre (cpl);
- The price of both furnace oil and diesel will increase by 1.0 cpl; and
- Propane prices will decrease by 4.2 cpl for Superior Propane; by 4.1 cpl for both Island Petroleum and Irving Energy Distribution and Marketing; and by 2.0 cpl for both Kenmac Energy and Noonan Petroleum.

Including taxes, pump prices for regular unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 130.4 to 131.6 cpl and prices for diesel will range from 125.6 to 126.7 cpl.

The maximum price for furnace oil is 94.1 cpl.

Propane prices will range from 81.3 to 82.9 cpl.
