The following is distributed by Island Information Services at the request of the Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission:

- PETROLEUM PRICING -

Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island, May 21, 2021 - The Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission approved the following petroleum prices effective 12:01 a.m., Friday, May 21, 2021:

- There is no change to the price of gasoline, furnace oil or diesel; and
- Propane prices will increase by 0.6 cpl for Irving Energy Distribution and Marketing; by 0.5 cpl for Island Petroleum; and there is no change in price for Superior Propane, Kenmac Energy, or Noonan Petroleum.

Including taxes, pump prices for regular unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 130.4 to 131.6 cpl and prices for diesel will range from 127.3 to 128.5 cpl.

The maximum price for furnace oil is 95.1 cpl.

Propane prices will range from 81.8 to 82.9 cpl.
